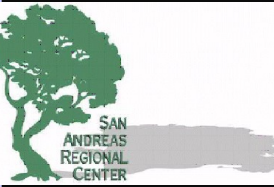


# 23rd Annual *Service Above Self* Awards

## ***AWARD CATEGORIES***

**Advocate of the Year** ~ An individual with a Developmental Disability (Consumer) who advocates and supports others by speaking on behalf of those who have no voice.

**Special Education Teacher of the Year** ~ K-12 teacher working with students in a classroom setting.

**Independent Living Staff of the Year** ~ Staff going Above & Beyond serving the consumers they support.

**Supportive Living Staff of the Year** ~ Staff going Above & Beyond serving the consumers they support.

**Residential Staff of the Year** ~ Staff going Above & Beyond serving the consumers they support.

**Service Provider of the Year** ~ An organization vendorized by San Andreas Regional Center going Above and Beyond in supporting the consumers they serve and support.

**Community Resource of the Year** ~ An organization in the community providing free services to individuals with developmental disabilities within a community setting.

**Volunteer of the Year** ~ a volunteer who works tirelessly supporting individuals or organizations serving the developmental disability community.

**Employer of the Year** ~ An employer who hires individuals with developmental disabilities while providing on the job training and wages.

**Clinical / Medical Service of the Year** ~ Serving the developmental disability community within clinical or medical service such as counseling, dentistry, physical therapy, nursing, or other health service needs.

**Legislative Advocate of the Year** ~ An elected official or legislative advocate who advocates for public policy that supports the developmental disability community.
