This is to notify you that the mileage reimbursement rate for California state employees using their personal vehicle for authorized state business decreased from \$.575/mile to \$.56/mile, effective January 1, 2021.

This change affects in-home respite agency providers claiming worker travel costs as a supplemental cost in accordance with Welfare & Institutions Code Section 4690.2(b)(6), "The rate for travel reimbursement methodology may include a supplemental amount of reimbursement for travel cost of respite workers using their private vehicles to and from and between respite sites."

Service code 862-01MR rate of reimbursement will be reduced effective January 1, 2021. SARC will adjust authorizations already paid for January 2021 and February 2021 on the next billing period in March 2021.
