



Dear San Andreas Service Providers,

Effective January 1, 2023, due to the implementation of Senate Bill (SB) 3, the minimum wage in California increased to \$15.50 per hour for all employers. As authorized by the current state budget and Welfare & Institutions (W&I) Code sections 4681.6(b), 4691.6(f) and (g), and 4691.9(b), many vendors will either receive, or be eligible to request, a rate increase if necessary to adjust employees' pay to comply with the new minimum wage. As the DDS bulletin states, providers with rates set by San Andreas Regional Center (also known as "median rates" or "negotiated rates") will need to complete and submit a Minimum Wage 2023 Rate Adjustment spreadsheet to San Andreas to request minimum wage rate increases. The Minimum Wage 2023 Rate Adjustment spreadsheet is located on the Provider Bulletins page of the San Andreas Regional Center website here: [Service Provider Bulletin](#). Please note that you will need to submit this spreadsheet no later than March 1, 2023.

This rate adjustment is to address the new statewide minimum wage for California.
